Adult Focus Advising Appointment includes:

Academic

- ; Determine academic status (i.e probation, dismissal) and obtain Student ID number.
- ; Determine last date of attendance
- ; Complete Undergraduate Enrollment form
- ; Review any previous coursework and academic options
- ; Discuss career objectives / major (Do I need to visit the Career Center, Student Union 211?)
- ; Obtain UANet ID and password (3309726888)
- ; Determine if placement tests are needed
 - o Arrange to take placement tests at the Computer Based Testing Center, located in Schrank Hall North 152. Website is www.uakron.edu/testing
- ; Make another advising appointment with Adult Focus to:
 - o Discuss placement test scores and options
 - o Schedule classes for the next term
 - o Learn My Akron, Springboard (online learning platform)
- ; Visit Zip Card Office for Student ID Card (Bring a copy of your Class Schedule)
- ; Veteran Students: Meet with Military Services Center to apply for VA benefits and to learn about services (3309727838 or www.uakron.edu/veterans)

Financial

- ; Determine financial standing
- ; Student needs to complete FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov (UA code: 003123)
- ; Explain SAR Report
- ; Explain Master Institutional Aid Application
- ; Explain My Akron regarding Accepting or Declining Award
- ; Check the status of your Financial Aid
- ; Explain what to do when student receives aid (what happens next?)
- ; Explain Refund Policy
- ; Explain keeping your Aid
